# RV Travel With Pets: Printable Checklist

## **Pre-Trip Prep**

- [] Vet check-up & updated vaccinations
- [] ID tag with current contact info
- [] Microchip registered with current address
- [] Pet travel insurance (optional but smart!)
- [] Practice drives to help them adjust
- [] Emergency contact list (vet, poison control, etc.)

#### **Pet Travel Kit**

- [] Food (enough for the full trip)
- [] Water bottles & bowls (spill-proof if possible)
- [] Medications & supplements
- [] Leash, harness, collar
- [] Poop bags / litter & litter box
- [] Bedding or crate
- [] Toys, chews, or comfort items
- [] Towel or blanket (multi-purpose!)
- [] Pet wipes / grooming supplies

## **RV Setup for Pets**

- [] Safe, cozy spot for your pet inside the RV
- [] Secured crate or harness for driving
- [] Climate control (A/C, fans, shade, window covers)
- [] RV pet-proofed (cords hidden, no loose snacks!)
- [] Pet temperature monitor (if leaving them alone)

## **Campground Gear**

- [] Portable fence or tie-out
- [] Booties or paw protection (hot surfaces!)
- [] ID tags on at all times
- [] Extra leash (because backups are always good!)
- [] Trash bags for cleanup
- [] Vaccination records (some campgrounds ask)

#### **Pet First Aid Kit**

- [] Bandages & gauze
- [] Antiseptic wipes or spray
- [] Tweezers (for ticks)
- [] Pet thermometer
- [] Vet wrap
- [] Any emergency meds

#### **Nice-to-Have Extras**

- [] GPS pet tracker
- [] Pet ramp or steps
- [] Motion-activated pet camera
- [] Cat tent or pop-up outdoor enclosure
- [] Calming spray or treats
- [] Favorite blanket or toy from home
